3	Return to Singing MB reported that the Cathedral was delighted to have the WCCC back and that the singing was fantastic. ER reviewed the content of the briefing paper and confirmed that in general the Covid-19 secure arrangements had worked well but the following points needed to be improved. • Assembling on College Green and queuing to sign-in. • Social distancing in the cloisters. • Face masks must be worn at all times in rehearsals. This is particularly important because of the age-based vulnerability of many members. • Rehearsal singing should be sotto voce. Booking for rehearsals in College Hall on 15/10/20 and 22/10/20 have been confirmed. • Doors will be left open. • Minimal baggage will be taken in. • A further visit to sort out a socially-distanced layout will be carried out. 4	Becoming a more integral part of the Cathedral Community MB and KO reported on the meeting which was held on 02/10/20 to draw up a draft of the Terms of Reference which will replace the WCCC's Constitution once the WCCC becomes an integral part of the Cathedral Community. They emphasised that the underlying principal was that as far as possible the WCCC should continue to operate in exactly the same way as it does now. The Committee considered the draft Terms of Reference document. During the discussion the following points arose: The Choir Arising from a query concerning the WCCC's complaints' procedures. The Choir is one of Worcester Cathedral's choirs, and is overseen by the Chapter of the Cathedral and fulfils its part within the Constitution and Statutes of

	responsible for the local and day to day management of the Choir's finances.	
	The revised ToR will be circulated and used in the next stage of the transition	
	procedures which will be a meeting to sort out financial procedures.	ко

	Cathedral's review of volunteer organisations. MB responded that it was	
	going on but it would be a long process.	
	Committee job descriptions may need to be reviewed in the light of the	
	fundamental changes, particularly the MD's.	
	Because of emergency arrangements put in place earlier in the year some	
	Committee roles are being carried out by more than one person. KO reminded	
	Committee members that Choir members agreed that the arrangements	
	should continue until the end of 2020 when they will be reviewed. He	
	suggested that review should wait at least until the transition to WCCC's new	
	status is complete.	ко
