4	Return to Singing What Next? ER's report on current Covid-19 situation and recommendations for a return to rehearsals were unanimously accepted and the following way forward, assuming that there were no changes in the current pathway out of lockdown, unanimously agreed. Rehearsals will start on 20/05/21 and continue every Thursday, except 03/06/21 (half term) until 21/07/21 be in College Hall, using similar sanitising and distancing arrangements to those used in November/December 20 last 75 minutes n.b. College Hall may not be available on 26/06 and 08/07. If this is the case an alternative venue will be arranged. KO will liaise with SH. KO will inform members of decision to restart rehearsals on 20/05/21 ER will update risk assessment and new instructions will be distributed to members in the week prior to 20/05/21 HR and CO will help with venue procedures and organisation Discussion of points raised by ER in her report lead to the unanimous conclusion that the WCCC's priority, after a lengthy period of disruption, was consolidation through a non-ambitious programme for the autumn of 21 and adjustment to the new normal. Social distancing etc. is likely to be the norm for some time. Venues such as Kempsey may well be non-viable for the foreseeable future.
